## **MASKS ARE REQUIRED**

In accordance with the Dallas County mask order which went into effect on Friday, June 19th, it is vital that all who enter our buildings wear a mask as long as the county ordinance remains in place. Thank you for helping us in our attempt to be good citizens obeying these measures.



## **MAINTAIN PHYSICAL DISTANCING**

Please maintain a minimum of a 6ft safety halo between you and others

- Seating in the worship center will be on the main floor only, and every other row. Please leave at least two seats between you and others who are not currently living in your home.
- Only the lobby and worship center will be accessible.
- Only the plaza doors and east doors to the lobby will be open.
- Additional handicapped parking will be designated near the east doors.
- Lobby restrooms will be open. Please self-limit to no more than 2-3 persons at a time.
- Please avoid handshakes and hugs for now. Smile and wave. Hand sanitizer will be provided throughout the lobby.
- For safety, no coffee service will be available for now.



## **PLANNED MEETING & ARRIVAL TIMES TO ENSURE SANITIZED SPACES**

- Classic Worship will begin at 9:30AM in the Worship Center. Worship Center doors open at 9:00AM and close at 9:30AM.
- The Worship Center will be sanitized prior to the next service.
- Contemporary Worship will begin at 5PM in the Worship Center. Worship Center doors open at 4:30PM and close at 5PM.
- If you arrive late to the worship service, someone will escort you through a rear entrance to avoid interrupting the video recording of the service.
- No children's Sunday School, nursery, or children's programming will be available at any service for the time being.
- We will dismiss by sections and rows to facilitate safe spacing as you depart.



## **PLEASE PERFORM HEALTH-CHECKS PRIOR TO ATTENDING**

Please check your temperature before leaving home. If any member of your family has a temperature of 100 or more, please don't attend for now. Please enjoy worship online.

Other symptoms that would indicate you should remain at home:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Sore throat
- Chills or chills with shaking
- Headache
- Digestive distress
- New loss of taste or smell

If you choose to attend in person, please be aware that the services will be recorded and will air online at a later date. Ensure that you are not seated directly behind a camera that obstructs your view.
